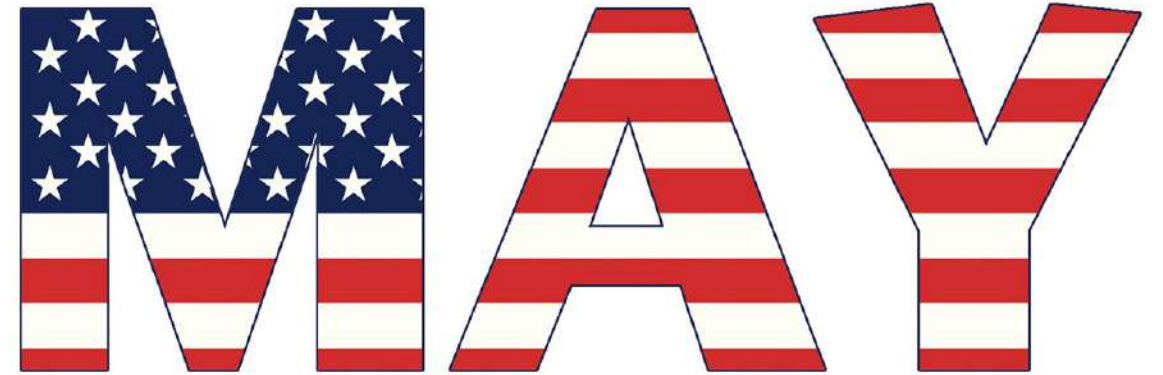

Dear Residents, Family, and Friends.

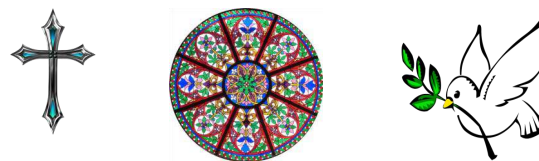
